Wollongong City Council (WCC) SLSI Liaison Meeting 7th March 2017

- Formation of Surf Club Leases:
 - Bulli Lease to be exhibited to the public next week. WCC have used Bellambi Lease model.
- Dune Management:
 - Port Kembla and Wollongong City beaches DM design to start next week.
- Service Level Agreement:
 - Discussion on Towradgi patrols and have advised WCC that Towradgi has informed SLSI 'that as at 15 February 2017, all patrols have been consolidated with the emphasis on ensuring that all the required awards are covered by the rostered patrol members. Towradgi have a new patrol roster that has commenced 26 February and will run until the end of season".
 - WCC await advice on the outcome of the judiciary to notify SLSI on any potential penalties in respect of the breaches.
- Sandon Point
 - Discussion on reduction of beach access pathways from 5 to 2. There is a 3-year plan to re-introduce 5 beach accesses.
