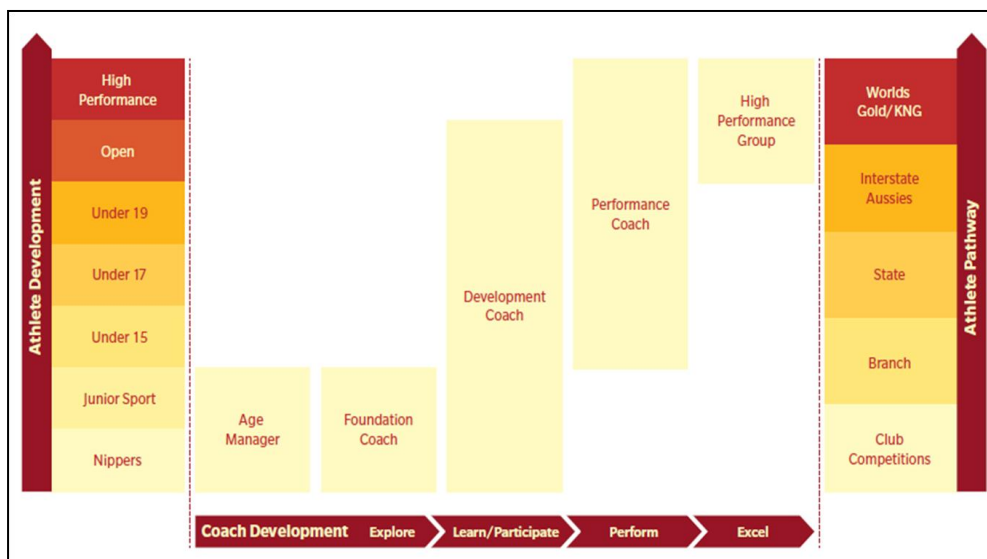

Following a comprehensive review of the SLSA Surf Sports Coaching Framework in 2012/13, SLSA has redesigned the way coaches are recruited, trained, supported, and retained. The result is a contemporary, flexible, interactive and purpose-built coach development framework, designed to ensure we are developing **great coaches** in all coaching environments and in all Surf Sport disciplines.

The new SLSA Coaching Framework is fundamentally taking over what was formally known as the Junior Coaching, Level 1, Level 2, and Level 3 courses. The major change to the coaching framework is that it is now discipline specific. SLSA Surf Sports Coach training sits under the umbrella of the National Coaching Accreditation Scheme (NCAS), which covers over 80 different sports throughout Australia and is managed by the Australian Sports Commission (ASC). SLSA has a 5-tiered Coaching Pathway which is outlined in Figure 1 below. *Note: The Age Manager qualification is not part of the National Coach Accreditation Scheme.*



The new coaching course format has two components; theory and practical. There are no more face to face coaching courses. The bulk of the course is done online, followed by the practical assessment which is carried out once the online modules are completed. This is organised between you and SLSNSW. All the theoretical components must be completed prior to the practical session.

If you wish to complete a Foundation or Development coaching course, nominations will be open in the months of July & October 2016. By nominating in one of these months, you are simply expressing interest that you wish to complete a course. Formal enrollment will be completed following the close of nominations where SLSNSW will contact you to provide more information about payment, how to access the modules, etc. You must then complete the online modules which are then followed by the practical assessment where the date and location will be communicated with all participants. You should allow 6-10 weeks from the time of nominating to the time you will receive your accreditation.

### **How to Nominate**

1. Please read the [Coaching Framework FAQ's](#) and '[About the SLSA Coaching Framework](#)' and familiarise yourself with the structure and requirements of the new courses.
2. All nominees must be a current financial member of a SLSC.
3. Ensure you have a [SLSA Members Portal](#) Account
4. Write down your SLSA Members Portal Account username; you will need this information when completing the nomination survey. Please contact the SLSA IT Help Desk [ithelp@slsa.asn.au](mailto:ithelp@slsa.asn.au) if you do not have one.
5. Complete the nomination survey via [www.surveymonkey.com/r/2016coaches](http://www.surveymonkey.com/r/2016coaches)  
 This survey will be open from 1-31 October 2016. No nominations will be accepted outside of these dates.
6. 1-2 weeks after the close of nominations, you will be contacted and given information on your chosen course, payment method and access to the online modules via the SLSA Members Portal where you will complete the online modules relevant to the coaching course you have chosen.
7. SLSNSW will contact you when you have completed the online modules to arrange a practical assessment with an Assessor. You cannot participate in the practical assessment if you have not completed all of the online modules.
8. If you are wishing to become a Boat Sweep in competition you must complete all the modules and practical assessments **before** the Sweep Accreditation Checklist.
