SLSNSW is seeking nominations for Team Management roles to assist the 2017 NSW Pool Rescue Interstate Team in competing at the 2017 SLSA Pool Rescue Interstate Championships. The 2017 SLSA Pool Rescue Interstate Championships will be held at SA Aquatic & Leisure Centre, Oaklands Park in South Australia on Friday 4 August.

### The roles available for the NSW Pool Rescue Interstate Team are:

- Head Coach (x1) – 2 year appointment
- Team Manager (x1) – 2 year appointment

### Requirements of Team Management:

Desirable experience and attributes for the above Team Management roles include but are not limited to:

- Proficient and Financial SLSC member, endorsement by Club & Branch
- Comprehensive knowledge of Surf Sports competition and rules, in particular to Pool Rescue competition
- Previous touring experience
- Current First Aid certificate
- Minimum Development Coach/Level 1 SLSA coaching accreditation
- Demonstrated ability to think innovatively and strategically

- Highly motivated and passionate in enhancing the success of Pool Rescue in NSW
- Compile a report within 3 weeks of completing competition.
- Organise various training sessions and development programs for Pool Rescue development in NSW for the appointment period.

#### **How to Nominate:**

1. Read and familiarise yourself with the [SLSNSW Selection Policy](#), especially section 3.3 (c) and [SLSNSW Athlete & Management Agreement](#). Members successful in gaining selection will be required to comply with the guidelines and expectations set out in these documents.
2. All nominees must be current financial members, proficient with their relevant awards, and be endorsed by both club and branch representatives prior to nomination. Endorsement letters must be provided upon submission of online nomination.
3. Complete the [nomination form](#) by **11pm Sunday 11 June 2017**.

It is anticipated that all successful athletes will be notified within two weeks following the close of nominations.

The appointment period will commence from the date of appointment and will expire 28 days after the 2018 Pool Rescue Championships.

#### **Cost:**

All costs (including travel & accommodation) are the responsibility of individuals. Selected athletes may already be attending the Australian Pool Rescue Championships with their club teams.

In the event of an athlete levy being introduced, Team Management will be liable for 50% of the confirmed amount.

#### **Elearning:**

All successful athletes and team management members will be required to complete both the [ASADA Level 1 Anti-Doping](#) and [Match Fixing](#) e-learning courses. Both of these courses are free of charge and provide an opportunity to develop a knowledge and understanding of anti-doping and match fixing in sport. Moving forward, SLSNSW strongly believe this is a great additive to the structure of any touring team and/or squad and is vital for elite competition and athlete development.

SLSNSW fully supports the new SLSA Anti-Doping and Match Fixing policies (SLSA Members Portal>Library/Governance/SLSA/Policy 5.01 & 5.02). Following the completion of each course, a completion certificate/email must be forwarded to Tim Piper [tpiper@surflifesaving.com.au](mailto:tpiper@surflifesaving.com.au). SLSNSW have organised with SLSA to have these courses uploaded on to SurfGuard as an award. Once completed, the courses do not have to be completed again, unless there is an update in information from the organisations. If anyone has previously completed either course, proof must be sent through to Tim in order to be recognised.
