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Summary	SLSNSW is calling for nominations for Team Management wishing to be involved in the 2017 NSW IRB Interstate Team or NSW IRB Development Team.

Surf Life Saving NSW (SLSNSW) is calling for nominations for Team Management roles to assist with the logistics of the 2017 NSW IRB Interstate and NSW Development Teams. This includes but is not limited to; organising training sessions, event logistics, athlete liaison, etc. The 2017 IRB Interstate Championships will be held on 14 July 2017 and will be followed by the 2017 Australian IRB Championships at Cudgen Headland SLSC.

The Team Management appointments are valid for the 2017 season (1 year) and will be selected based on previous experience and awards. Team Management appointments will be selected by the SLSNSW Director of Surf Sports in conjunction with the SLSNSW President and Sports Manager.

The roles available for the NSW Interstate Team are:

- Head Coach (x1)
- Assistant Coach (x1)
- Team Manager (x1)

The roles available for the NSW Development Team are:

- Head Coach (x1)
- Team Manager (x1)

Requirements of Team Management:

Desirable experience and attributes for the above Team Management roles include but not limited to:

- Head and Assistant Coaches are required to have completed a Development Coach – IRB Award.
- Provide planning and logistical support to SLSNSW for all development/high performance clinics and team trainings and are expected to attend.
- Team Management will be required to submit a written report within 3 weeks of the completion of the carnival.
- Proficient and Financial SLSC member, endorsed by club & branch
- Comprehensive knowledge of Surf Sports competition and rules, in particular to the NSW State Team
- Previous touring experience
- Current First Aid certificate
- Demonstrated ability to think innovatively and strategically
- Highly motivated and passionate in enhancing the success of the NSW State Team

How to Nominate:

- 1) Read and familiarise yourself with the [Selection Policy](#), especially section 3.3(c) and the [SLSNSW Athlete & Management Agreement](#). Successful applicants will be required to comply with the guidelines and expectations set out in these documents.
- 2) All nominees must be current financial members, proficient with their relevant awards, and be endorsed by both club and branch representatives prior to nomination. Endorsement letters must be provided upon submission of online nomination.
- 3) Individuals may nominate for the Interstate team, Development team or both. SLSNSW will confirm appointments in due course.
- 4) Complete the [Online Nomination](#) by **11pm Sunday 4 December 2016**.

Cost:

All costs (including travel & accommodation) are the responsibility of individuals. Selected Team Management may already be attending the Australian IRB Championships with their club teams.

If an athlete levy is introduced, Interstate/Development Team Management will be liable for 50% of the confirmed amount.

E-Learning:

All successful team management members will be required to complete both the [ASADA Level 1 Anti-Doping](#) and [Match Fixing](#) e-learning courses. Both of these courses are free of charge and provide an opportunity to develop a knowledge and understanding of anti-doping and match fixing in sport. Moving forward, SLSNSW strongly believe this is a great additive to the structure of any touring team and/or squad and is vital for elite competition and athlete development.

SLSNSW fully supports the new SLSA Anti-Doping and Match Fixing policies (SLSA Members Portal>Library/Governance/SLSA/Policy 5.01 & 5.02). Following the completion of each course, a completion certificate/email must be forwarded to Tim Piper tpiper@surflifesaving.com.au. SLSNSW have organised with SLSA to have these courses uploaded on to SurfGuard as an award. Once completed, the courses do not have to be completed again, unless there is an update in information from the organisations. If anyone has previously completed either course, proof must be sent through to Tim in order to be recognised.
