Subject:	Grant Opportunity – Central Coast Stronger Communities Fund – Community Grants Program			

The second round of the **Central Coast Stronger Communities Fund – Community Grants Program** for incorporated not-for-profit community organisations in the Central Coast Council area is now open and closes 24 February 2017. This funding program aims to kickstart the delivery of projects that improve community infrastructure and services.

- Grants of \$10,000 to \$50,000 for incorporated not-for-profit community groups for projects that build more vibrant, sustainable and inclusive local communities.
- All applications must address one or more of the community priority areas.

Priority areas include:

1. Creating a vibrant, caring and connected community
2. Creating safer communities
3. Valuing the communities local history, culture and diversity
4. Ensuring fair access and opportunity to participate in Community Life
5. Providing opportunities for active and healthy lifestyles
6. Advancing community expertise, capacity, networks, resources and innovation
7. Building stronger more resilient communities
8. Enhancing the sense of local identity

Please note the following key points:

- Applications must clearly demonstrate the need for the project and the organisation's capacity to deliver the project.
- A significant number of attachments are required to be included with an application therefore clubs need to plan their applications in advance.
- Organisations applying for capital works funding should be prepared to include documents additional to those outlined in the guidelines to support their application, such as building plans, relevant approvals, etc. If relevant approvals have not been obtained at the time of this funding round, organisations may like to consider applying in a future round of the program in 2017 to increase their chances of receiving funding.
- Organisations that have funding from either Wyong or Gosford Councils that has not been acquitted, or have existing funding commitments from a Council, are not eligible for funding.
- Successful applicants must provide three monthly reports to the Council on their project as well as a final report.
- For clubs that have a nippers program for young people with special needs, this Fund could be a good opportunity for capital works, equipment and/or program funding to support the delivery of the program.

The closing date for applications is **24 February 2017**.
