- SLSNSW will collate the nomination results and successful candidates will be notified thereafter.

Additional Information

- All Senior Official appointments will be for the duration of ONE season.
- All currently appointed Carnival Deputy Referees for the 2017/2018 season, wishing to nominate for the Carnival Referee positions may do so at their own discretion.
- The term of each appointment will end **28 days** after the final year of the appointment.
 - For example, the 2018 NSW State Open Championships Carnival Referee will be required to fulfill this appointment until April 2018 (one month after State Open Championships concludes).
 - Each appointed senior official will be required to submit a written report during this **28 day period**.
- All appointed Officials will be required to attend Championships meetings (including teleconferences) which will be held prior. All times and locations will be outlined in the Officials Appointment Circular distributed at a later date or as otherwise advised by SLSNSW.
- Appointed officials may be responsible for the cost of travel and their own accommodation for the Championships.
- Successful officials must be a currently accredited and a current financial member of a SLSC in the 2017/2018 season.

Medical Form

- All Officials should ensure that they are physically capable to carry out their important functions over the days of the Championships, and are encouraged to undertake a medical check prior to the departure to the Championships.

- Completion of this form is not mandatory but is strongly encouraged.
