After a successful 12 months of rolling out SLSA's National Coaching Accreditation Scheme (NCAS), Surf Life Saving NSW (SLSNSW) now intends on increasing the number of Coaching Assessors within the state. This upskilling course is available to members who currently hold a Development Coaching Award and who wish to help SLSNSW to further improve both quality and quantity of Surf Sport coaches within NSW.

The Coaching Assessor Course will be accessible online, through SLSA's online portal, EtrainU. It will be available free of charge however, there will be a limit to how many nominations are accepted. This award is valid as long your Coaching Accreditation is valid. By undertaking this course it is expected that within reason, you are able to assess prospective coaches upon request.

### How to Nominate

1. All nominees must be a current financial member of a SLSC.
2. All nominees must hold a current Development Coaching Award.
3. Ensure you have a [SLSA Members Portal Account](#). Please contact the [SLSA IT Help Desk](#) if you have any concerns.
4. [Complete the online nomination form](#). No nominations will be accepted after 11pm on Sunday 30 July.
5. SLSNSW will grant you access to the Coaching Assessor Online Modules via the SLSA Members Portal.
6. SLSNSW will contact you when you have completed the online modules to arrange a practical assessment with an Assessor. You cannot participate in the practical assessment if you have not completed all of the online modules.
