The <u>ClubGRANTS Category 3 2017-18 Infrastructure Grants</u> program is now open for applications. The funding is made available from the reinvestment of 0.4 per cent of gaming profits from clubs across NSW. A total pool of over \$12 million will be provided this year.

Grants of \$100,000 to \$300,000 are available for Sport & Recreation projects for use towards the costs of construction, alteration, renovation, completion and fitout of buildings.

Key Details:

- Applicants can apply once per round.
- Applications must include:
 - o **Development Approval** certificate or reference number, or evidence of exemption
 - Up to three letters demonstrating community support for the proposal from groups that will directly benefit and engage with the planned infrastructure project. Letters from government employees or representatives are not accepted.
- Successful projects must be completed within two years of the funding commencing.
- In the assessment process consideration is given to projects which provide benefit to:
 - o Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities
 - o Regional and remote communities
 - People with disability
 - Culturally and linguistically diverse communities
