<b>Subject:</b>	Grant Opportunity – ClubGRANTS Category 3 2017-18 Infrastructure Grants

The **ClubGRANTS Category 3 2017-18 Infrastructure Grants** program is now open for applications. The funding is made available from the reinvestment of 0.4 per cent of gaming profits from clubs across NSW. A total pool of over \$12 million will be provided this year.

***A number of changes have been made to the program therefore please consider the following information carefully***

The program will now have four rounds across the year, as follows:

Grants of **\$100,000 to \$300,000** are available for Sport & Recreation projects for use towards the costs of **construction, alteration, renovation, completion and fitout of buildings.**

#### Key Details:

- Applicants can apply once per round.
- Applications must include:
  - **Development Approval** certificate or reference number, or evidence of exemption
  - Up to three letters demonstrating **community support** for the proposal from groups that will directly benefit and engage with the planned infrastructure project. *Letters from government employees or representatives are not accepted.*
- Successful projects must be completed within two years of the funding commencing.
- In the assessment process consideration is given to projects which provide benefit to:
  - Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities
  - Regional and remote communities
  - People with disability
  - Culturally and linguistically diverse communities
