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<b>Summary:</b>	SLSNSW is calling for nominations from Team Management wishing to gain selection in the 2019 NSW Youth Pathway Cup Team.

SLSNSW is seeking nominations for Team Management roles to assist the 2019 NSW Youth Pathway Cup (YPC) Team in competing at the 2019 Youth Pathway Cup to be held at Newport Beach, New South Wales on Thursday 24 January.

All successful nominees will be required to attend a team camp from 22 January – 25 January 2019. Accommodation has been booked at the Sydney Academy of Sport, Narrabeen. More information will be provided to successful applicants.

### The roles available for the NSW YPC Team are:

- Lead Coach (x1) – 2 year appointment
- Assistant Coach (x2) – 2 year appointment
- Team Manager (x1) – 2 year appointment

### Requirements of Team Management:

- All nominees must be current financial members and hold any relevant awards
- Comprehensive knowledge of Surf Sports competition and rules
- Previous touring experience
- Current First Aid certificate
- Minimum Foundation/Level 1 coaching accreditation (coaches)
- Demonstrated ability to think innovatively and strategically
- Highly motivated and passionate in enhancing the success of NSW athletes, particularly youth (U14/U15)
- All Team Management will also undertake chaperone responsibilities
- Compile a report within three weeks of completing competition (team manager)
- Assist with organising various training sessions and development programs for the NSW YPC team within the appointment period
- SLSNSW strongly encourages females to nominate, at least 1 management staff from the opposite gender should be appointed

### How to Nominate:

1. All nominating members are asked to familiarise themselves with the SLSNSW [Selection Policy](#) and the SLSNSW [Athlete & Management Agreement](#). All Team Management will be required to comply with the guidelines and expectations set out in these documents.
2. Complete the [online nomination form](#) by **11pm Sunday 8 July 2018**.
3. All nominations must be endorsed by both Club and Branch representatives prior to selection, please contact your Club and Branch to acquire letters of endorsement – Any nomination that fails to meet these requirements will not be accepted.

The appointment period will commence from the date of appointment and will expire 28 days after the 2020 Youth Pathway Cup.

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### Team Levy:

Management levy of 50% of the athlete levy will be payable for all successful team management members to assist with the cost of the team, including but not limited to uniform, accommodation, food and transport. Clubs will be invoiced for this team levy and it will then be up to the club to pass on this expense onto the individual. Final costings will be released to successful team management.

### E-Learning:

All successful athletes and team management members will be required to complete both the ASADA Level 1 Anti-Doping and Match Fixing e-learning courses. Both of these courses are free of charge and provide an opportunity to develop a knowledge and understanding of anti-doping and match fixing in sport. Moving forward, SLSNSW strongly believe this is a great additive to the structure of any touring team and/or squad and is vital for elite competition and athlete development.

SLSNSW fully supports the new SLSA Anti-Doping and Match Fixing policies (SLSA Members Portal>Library/Governance/SLSA/Policy 5.1 1 & 5.02). Following the completion of each course, a completion certificate/email must be forwarded to Chiara Nowland [cnowland@surflifesaving.com.au](mailto:cnowland@surflifesaving.com.au) . SLSNSW have organised with SLSA to have these courses uploaded on to SurfGuard as an award. Once completed, the courses do not have to be completed again, unless there is an update in information from the organisations.
